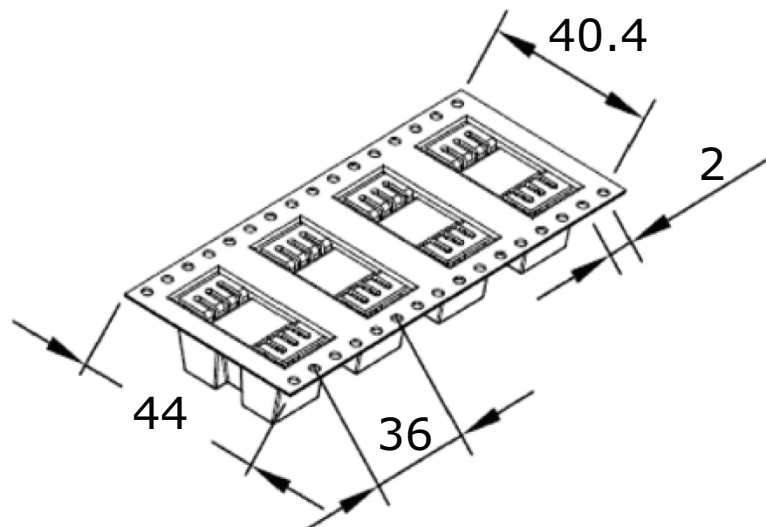


Recommended Copper Pad Layout
